

Using a Census Tracker

The following is an example of how to use this Census Tracker. You can print them out, and write in the columns, the information that is presented on each Census. Using the spreadsheet is helpful because your rows and columns can expand. It is the little facts that will help you decide if the family members are the same for each Census found, especially if they have moved around the USA. Compare the occupation, ages of family members, where each person was born, even the father and mother of the parents. You may find small inconsistencies in ages, or places of birth, but if the majority of the information you've written down is similar, then you have a better conclusion about the family.
